

GUIDELINES FOR THE FLORIDA SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS SCHOLARSHIP - STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

<u>STUDENT ELIGIBILITY –</u> To be eligible for the FSE Scholarship the student applicant shall:

- 1. Be a citizen of the United States.
- 2. Have been a resident of Florida for two years preceding the academic year for which an application is made.
- 3. Be a Political Science/Public Administration/Business Administration or Journalism/Mass Communication major. No post-graduate or second-degree students.
- 5. Be at least a junior in college or have enough credits for enrollment as a junior prior to the application deadline.
- 6. Submit two current letters of recommendation: one from the college or university last attended or graduated from; and one from a citizen of good standing in the community.
- 7. Submit a resume of your high school and/or college activities, as well as, what you have done for your community.
- Demonstrate a financial need and furnish a financial statement, which shows what your own contribution is to your educational expenses. (Student does not have to submit an official form, can just send a statement of their financial need.)
- 9. Have maintained a "C" average or above for the previous school year.
- 10. Be registered to vote. (Written verification required by Supervisor of Elections where student is registered to vote.)
- 11. Be available for an interview by the Supervisor of Elections in the county where student is registered to vote.

<u>ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION</u> – Scholarship must be given to student attending a Florida university or college, which is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools.

STIPULATION – The scholarship check will be made payable to the school where student will be attending.

APPLICATION -

- 1. Must be received by the Supervisor of Elections in the county the student is registered to vote by March 8, 2024.
- 2. Letters of recommendation **MUST ACCOMPANY APPLICATION OR BE RECEIVED BY THE DEADLINE.**
- <u>SELECTION</u> Each county's Supervisor will review all applications received and select one finalist to be forwarded to the FSE Scholarship Committee, along with a letter of recommendation for the applicant. The FSE Scholarship Committee will select three winners (\$1,200 each) from the finalists submitted by the Supervisors. A student who has received the scholarship award may make a second application the following year.
